Patrick Michael Fitzgerald (1965) is an Irish artist who lives and works in Zalla, Spain. His art education was at Chelsea School of Art in London where he gained both his B.A. (1987) and M.A. (1988) in Fine Art Painting. He has exhibited widely in Europe and elsewhere. His work is represented in a number of important collections including the Irish Museum of Modern Art, Dublin; O.P.W. (The Irish State Collection); ARTIUM(Centro-Museo Vasco de Arte Contemporáneo, Vitoria, Spain) and the Josef & Anni Albers Foundation, Bethany, USA, amongst others. Fitzgerald's paintings are a response to things that surround him in his daily life while also being exploratory and a reflection on the history of the medium itself and its possibilities. He is also influenced by other art forms such as music, poetry, literature and cinema. For him, painting is not just a visual phenomenon but is also a bodily and haptic experience. Though his works have an economy of means and are usually modest in size, Fitzgerald seeks a certain kind of

(아일랜드 주립 컬렉션), 스페인 비토리아의 Artium(Centro-Museo Vasco de Arte Contemporáneo), 그리고 미국 Bethany의 Josef & Anni Albers Foundation을 포함한 중요한 컬렉션에 소장되어 있다.

피츠제럴드의 작업은 일상 생활에서 그를 둘러싸고 있는 것들에 대한 반응이며, 회화라는 매체 자체의 역사와 그것의 가능성에 대한 성찰이기도 하다. 그의 작업은 또한 음악, 시, 문학, 그리고 영화와 같은 다른 예술 장르의 영향을 받는다. 그에게 그림은 시각적인 현상일 뿐만 아니라 신체적이고 촉각적인 경험이기도 하다. 그의 작품들은 소박하고 크기가 작지만, 피츠제럴드는 시간이 지나면서 천천히 축적되는 특정한 종류의 강렬함과 성찰적인 경험을 추구한다.
